

What is Tourette Syndrome?

Tourette Syndrome is a medical condition characterised by motor and vocal tics - involuntary movements and noises.

Other symptoms - all involuntary - may include:

- The use of obscene or socially inappropriate words or gestures
- Imitation of other people's speech or gestures
- The compulsion to touch people or things
- Other disorders often associated with TS include Attention Deficit Disorder (with or without hyperactivity), Obsessive Compulsive Behaviours, anxiety, problem behaviours (aggression, rage, etc).

In case of accident or medical treatment

This person may be on medication, which could include one or more of the following: typical or atypical neuroleptics, tricyclic antidepressants, SSRIs, clonidine, stimulants (e.g. methylphenidate, atomoxetine).
